Quorum was established.

Mark Cappell, city councilman, was present for meeting. He discussed the planning and execution of the G.O. bond as it relates to the roundabout at 15th and Reed Market.

He answered questions from the general public who were present.

The 2-14-2013 board minutes were approved by voice vote.

Kent reported on the progress the City of Bend was making for addressing CSR priorities for OFDNA.

There were no CSR requests for our neighborhood.

Kent reported on the latest NART meeting. Cheryl Howard is organizing Weed Pull and Earth Day activities for neighborhood associations. OFDNA is not participating in the Earth Day activities, but will have a presence at the Weed Pull event. Nan Loveland will be sending out information to members concerning the Weed Pull.

Henry reported that he delivered a letter from the Board to the city council concerning the design of the roundabout from a two lane to a one lane roundabout. The Board pointed out in the letter to the councilors the problems associated with not allowing north and southbound traffic to continue when there was a train event.

It was reported that there are ongoing talks with the developer Ditz about his property on the southwest corner of 15th and Reed Market St.

It was confirmed that speakers from the Sheriff's office plus Robin Lewis and Nick Arnis from the City of Bend transportation department will speak at the General Membership meeting in April.

James and Kent confirmed that they would like to be re-elected to the board for another two year term.
